## PARIS CALHOUN

Jase Swartz scored his 1st TD of the day with 3 seconds left in the 2nd quarter to keep his team in it at the half, 21-14.

But UB could not recover even with 2 more touchdowns being scored by Swartz and Benjamin Burgasser as USC's Evan Rose matched those 2 with 2 scores of his own and Brady Taggart scoring the go ahead touchdown after breaking away from the tough defensive pack.
