

BILLS vs. DOLPHINS

In the first half, six different players found the end zone, with Matteo Prezioso, Ryker Ching'anda, and Timothy Kurplewski scoring for the BILLS, while James Warner, Alexander Lawson, and Dylan Spence broke the goal line for the DOLPHINS.

Zachary Orlowski thwarted one of the BILLS' drives with an interception, leading to a 21-21 tie at halftime.

Emmanual Desouza kicked off the second half with a touchdown and made it challenging for the DOLPHINS to take the lead by executing three impressive flag pulls on defense.
